CHRIST CHURCH MOURNS THE DEATH OF ROBERT WILLIS, DEAN EMERITUS OF CANTERBURY

We are grieved to share that Robert Willis, our November Theologian in Residence, died suddenly and peacefully this week while a resident fellow at Berkeley Divinity School at Yale. Robert will be remembered for his 20 years as Dean of Canterbury Cathedral and cherished for the connection his online Garden Congregation brought to an isolated COVID world beginning in 2020. Robert was to be our Theologian in Residence from November 7-10. Sadly, we must now cancel the planned fireside chat on Thursday, November 7, and the half-day retreat on Saturday, November 9. The Christ Church Choir will present, as planned, the *Music in Memoriam* concert on Sunday, November 10, at 4 PM and will sing Phillip Ledger's *Requiem* in Robert's memory.
