Christ Church 2024 financial results ended the year essentially on budget with interest and rental income offsetting a 1% shortfall in pledges. On the expense side, a contribution to the preschool Christ Church supports in the Dominican Republic is reflected under Parish Programs and is offset by transfers from the dedicated and restricted funds contributed for this mission work. Administrative expenses were below budget due to open staff positions for a portion of the year, and the rector and her staff managed program costs prudently throughout the year. Overall, through December 31, 2024, Christ Church closed the year with a slight surplus of \$24,380, which is accounted for in the line for Contingency/Vestry Allocations to balance 2024 expenses to income. The Contingency Fund is a restricted account allocated at the designation of the vestry, sometimes used to close a budget's shortfall.

The **2025 ministry budget** estimates a 2% decrease in income and expenses that sustain our worship, fellowship, and service to others.
